- Types of disabilities or life-limiting conditions of the children you support.
- Number of parents/siblings you support.
- Do you support children and families from BAME communities?

Can you tell us more about the area you work in (approx. 150 words)

You might consider telling us the following:

- Is the area in which you work urban or rural?
- Is it an area of high deprivation?
- What are the biggest challenges facing the children and families you work with?

Do you charge families for your services? If so, how much?

Please tell us how much it costs families to access your services.

Has your organisation received funding from True Colours in the past?

Please state yes or no, or if you're not sure whether you've received funding in the past, please put 'not known'.
